


Half of the training takes place at the San Bernardino County Sheriffs Emergency Vehicle Operations Center who has put on an 80 hour "Motor School".

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding applications for FY 17/18 are available on the City's website and due on December 7, 2016. Eleven people representing seven public service agencies attended the voluntary application workshop on Wednesday 11/9/16 at City Hall. There will be a public hearing at the December 13, 2016 City Council meeting to consider interested party comments and views in preparation for allocation of approximately \$811,000 in CDBG funding and development of the Annual Action Plan for July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
