FLAG SALUTE AND MOMENT OF SILENCE: Chairperson Modica

1. Approval of Minutes of November 8, 2006

Commissioner Berry moved to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner
Marc-Aurele seconded, and motion passed 5-0.

2. Report of Council Action on November 8, 2006 meeting:

Informational. Traffic Engineer Patricia Castillo reported on the status of the items submitted to the City Council by the Traffic Commission.

3. Request for Speed Limit Signs on Auto Blvd., Carriage Dr. and Auto Mall Blvd.

Castillo reported on the request for speed limit signs. The Prima Facie speed for Auto Blvd., Carriage Dr. and Auto Mall Blvd. is 25 mph. Staff recommends the installation of 25 mph speed limit signs along the specified streets.

Commissioner Berry moved to accept Staff recommendation to install 25 mph
speed limit signs along Auto Blvd., Carriage Dr. and Auto Mall Blvd. Commissioner Asher

seconded, and motion passed 5-0.

4. Request Approval of Street Names for Tract Map 29843
(Teresa Fee, Building Technician)

Castillo reported on the request for street name approval. Staff recommends approval of the names as presented.

Commissioner Oltman moved approve the street names as presented. Commissioner Marc-Aurele seconded, and motion passed 5-0.

5. 5 Year Speed Survey Update on Various Streets in the City

Castillo reported on the routine speed survey update. Staff recommends the approval of the updates to various streets throughout the City.

Commissioner Oltman moved to accept Staff recommendation and approve the speed survey updates. Commissioner Berry seconded, and motion passed 5-0.

6. Action Item List

Informational. Castillo reported on the status of items previously brought before the Commission. Castillo stated that by November 16, 2006, City crews had installed the ADA access ramps along Lyon Avenue, near Acacia Avenue, and the school signage along Ramona Street.

Commissioner Berry thanked staff for the promptness of the installation of ADA access ramps along Lyon Ave. near Acacia Ave; they have been much appreciated by the public.

A. Sidewalk Obstruction on Lyon Ave., Near the Railroad Tracks

B. Speeding Along North Hemet Street

Commissioner Asher asked if anything could be done about the speeding that takes place along North Hemet Street. Traffic Corporal Dan Reinbolt replied that the Police Department would increase patrols of the area.
